



Welcome to Doggy Daycare at K9 Country Club!

Here's the information you need to ensure a fun and safe visit...

New dogs (big and little) should be dropped off in the office until they are accustomed to the group they will be playing with. Big dogs may eventually be dropped off directly at the Doggy Daycare building. We will let you know when the time comes to bring your big dog directly to the daycare building. Little dogs will always be dropped off and picked up in the office.

Unless it's for a medical or health reason, do not bring a lunch for your dog.

Also, no toys, treats or other items from home are allowed. **Your dog and his/her leash are the only things you need to bring.**

Drop-off times:

Big dogs... 7:30 – 9 a.m.

Little dogs... 8 – 9 a.m.

It is important to bring your dog by 9 a.m. Dogs are pack animals and have formed their favorite play groups by this time in the morning. Late arrivals cause a huge disruption to the group and can cause quarrels among the dogs.

Pick-up times:

Pick-up time is between 2:30 and 5:30 p.m. Little dogs should be picked up in the office. Big dogs who are dropped off in the daycare building may be picked up in the daycare building.

Other requirements:

- ▶ Your dog should be fed at least **one hour** prior to his/her arrival at daycare.
- ▶ Flea protection must be applied **monthly**.
- ▶ Bordetella vaccinations are required **every six months**.

Payment






Please pay at drop-off time rather than at pick-up time. If your dog comes more than once weekly, we can keep track so you can pay once per week instead of daily. We have a **Buy 10 Get One Free** special for our Doggy Daycare clients. Ask us about it if you're interested.

Rules to remember:

All of our rules are for the protection of the dogs in our care.

-  When dropping off or picking up your dog at K9 Country Club, your dog must be leashed and under control at all times. **No exceptions.**
-  If you bring your dog directly to the Doggie Daycare building in the morning, put your dog in the “meet and greet” area, put your dog’s leash away, say goodbye, and quickly exit the building. **Do not talk to the other dogs and do not reach over the fence to pet them.**
-  For clients who go directly into the Doggy Daycare building: If the dogs are in the play yards that adjoin the walkway into the daycare building, do not talk to or pet them. **Talking to or petting the dogs is dangerous for you and for your dog.**
-  Again, for clients who go directly into the Doggy Daycare building: When you pick up your dog at the end of the day, get your dog’s leash, stand quietly and wait for someone to bring your dog to you. **NEVER let your dog out through any gate unless instructed to do so.**
-  Children who are unable to remain quiet and respectful should not accompany you into the Doggie Daycare building.

If your dog does poorly or has any problems, we will tell you. If you have questions or concerns about your dog’s experience at Doggie Daycare, please schedule a time to talk with us. Because it’s such a busy time, we are generally not able to chat with you during drop-off and pick-up hours.
